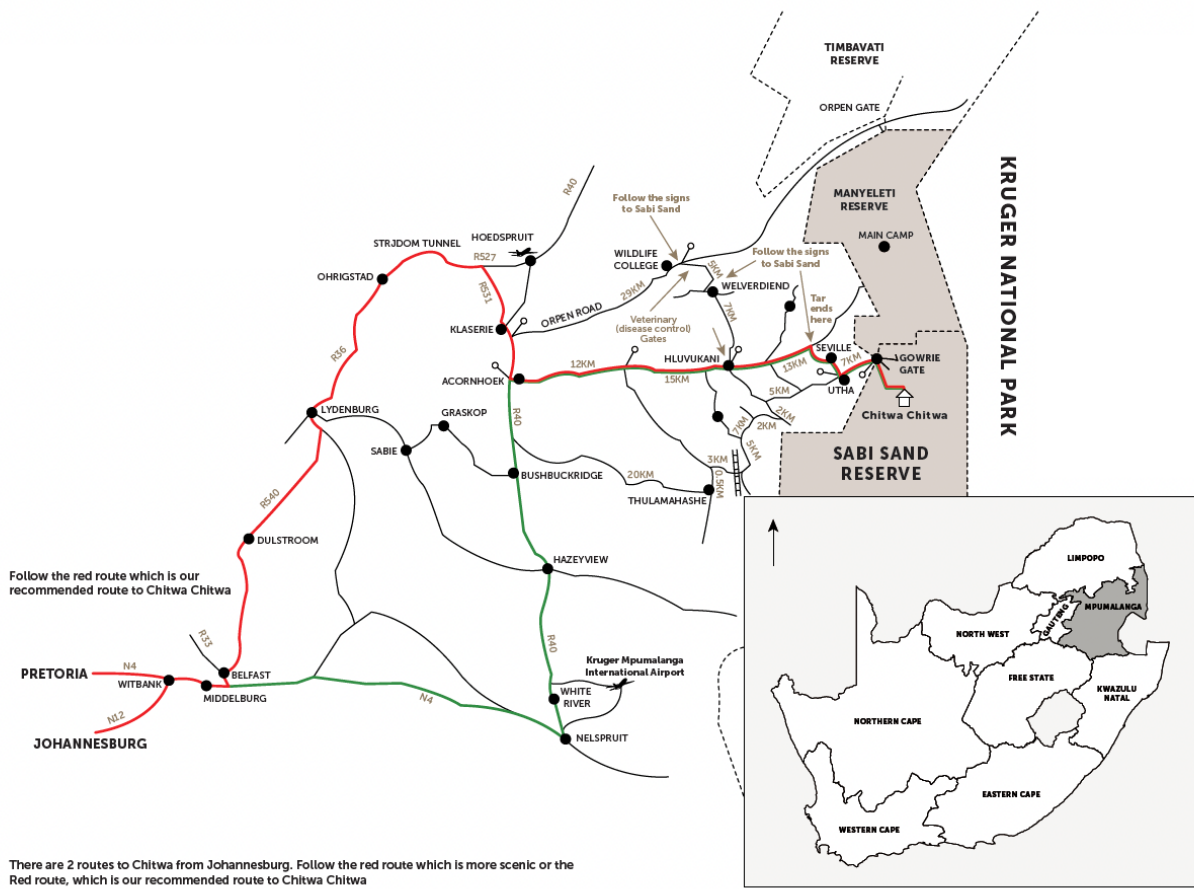

Getting to Chitwa





CHITWA CHITWA

From Johannesburg travel East via the N12 to Witbank.

From Pretoria travel East via the N4 to Witbank.

- GPS assisted routes are not recommended, as these are not the most direct / updated routes.
- It is approximately 500km in total from Johannesburg and 140km from Nelspruit, with the last 25km stretch on gravel roads which are not in good condition.
- From Acornhoek onwards there are signs: 'Sabi Sand' follow these signs.
- Please do not get out of your vehicle once inside the Sabi Sands Reserve.
- Once inside the Sabi Sabds Reserve, look out for the 'FOLLOW THE HERD' signage which will lead you all the way to Chitwa Chitwa Lodge.

BY ROAD:

The road transfer from Johannesburg to Chitwa Chitwa takes approximately 5 hours. The lodge is situated in the northern area of the Sabi Sand and access is via Gowrie Gate, near the Orpen Gate of the Kruger National Park. Chitwa Chitwa is a scenic three-hour drive from Nelspruit.

ROAD TRANSFERS:

From the airport can be arranged by Eastgate Safaris. Visit www.eastgatesafaris.co.za for more information.

BY AIR:

The lodge is easily accessible by air from Oliver Tambo in Johannesburg with a flying time of approximately 1 and a half hours. Direct connecting flights are also available from Kruger International which take just over half an hour and from Eastgate Airport in Hoedspruit with 25 minutes flying time.
